

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I'd request that we go under call if we are not under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh, okay. The question is shall the house go under call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are under call. Please return to your desks and record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return and record your presence. I'd appreciate it if we'd speed it up a little. I'd like to get to some kind of a vote today, if possible. Please record your presence. Senator Beutler. Senator Haberman. Senator Hoagland, Rod Johnson, Carson Rogers, Carson Rogers. May I introduce some 56 students, guests of Senator Goll, from Tekamah Herman High School. They are in the south balcony, accompanied by an instructor. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Legislature. We're looking for Senator Chambers and Senator Rod Johnson. Do you want to continue without Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Hoagland?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: (Response inaudible.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Roll call vote has been asked. We're voting on the Hoagland amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. Refer to pages 1052-53 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Call is raised. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Which amendment is this, Mr. Clerk? Could you read it.

CLERK: This is the one, Senator, to amend Senator Lamb's amendment, REQ#490, by adding the following at the end of Section 19...

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'll withdraw that, Mr. Clerk.
