

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes. Senator Scofield voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Beutler. Senator, this is REQ#674. (See Beutler amendment found on pages 1053-55 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, there has been some interest expressed in an interim study, and...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Excuse me, Senator Beutler, just a second. (Gavel.) Let's please hold our conversation down so we can hear. Thank you. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I think that it is appropriate that we do have an interim study. Of course, we've had a discussion here as to how you do this interim study, that is whether you pass the bill and have the interim study, or whether you strike the provisions of the bill and have the interim study. What I am offering to you today is a setup for an interim study, a serious interim study, but the provisions of the bill are not stricken. The bill would go into effect. As you know it has an effective date in May of next year, so that it is at the end of the next legislative session. So the bill goes into effect, but we have an interim study. I passed out to you a copy of how the study would be set up, the subjects that it would cover and how the members of the study group would be organized and chosen. Basically it would provide for reviewing everything that is in 662. As we go along and as people come to us with problems when you have changes of this proportion undoubtedly there are going to be some small problems, I don't think there is any doubt about that. Undoubtedly we will have to make some small adjustments. So I suggest to
