

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Jackie Smith amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

SENATOR SMITH: I'd like to have a record vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, record vote is asked for.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1057 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have anything else?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are back to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Hoagland and Remmers would move to amend.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: We would withdraw that amendment, Mr. Speaker, and present the idea at some future date. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb would move to amend.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I would also withdraw that amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: So ordered.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard or Senator Landis, which one wants to handle the bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is in the form of a closing on the bill?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, you are on the discussion on the bill. You're not exactly closing the discussion. You are beginning the closing.
