CLERK: Mr. President, the first report I have is by Senator Hefner as Chair of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. The report is on the appointment of Mr. Wayne Sides to the State Electrical Board. The report is on page 1033 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hefner, please.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, Miscellaneous Subjects Committee met the other day and Mr. Wayne Sides from Grant, Nebraska appeared before us. He has been appointed by the Governor to serve on the State Electrical Board for another five years. He has served the past five years. And, like I said before, he is from Grant, Nebraska.
