ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 486 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record as found on pages 1096-97 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes with the emergency clause attached. Move on to LB 508.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Began reading LB 508 on Final Reading.)
