

SENATOR LABEDZ: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 4 nays, Madam President, to go under call.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The house is under call. All senators are asked to take their seats. All those in their office, please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Please record your presence. Have you all voted? I mean checked in, I'm sorry. All senators within the hearing of my voice, please return to the Chamber. We are under call. We need Senator Beutler, Senator Lamb, Senator Schmit, Senator Scofield. Senator Jackie Smith, would you please record your presence. Senator Warner, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Harris, please return to the Chamber. If you are already here, record your presence. Senator Schmit, record your presence. We're looking for Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Lamb, everyone is here. Senator Miller has been excused. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read as found on pages 1108-1109 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The amendment to the committee amendments has been adopted. Are there any more amendments?

CLERK: I have nothing further than committee amendments.
