LB 40, 47, 76, 114

SENATOR MARSH: LB 40 is passed on Final Reading. We are ready for LB 47 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 47 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR MARSH: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. This will require 33 votes. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1128 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 2 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 47e has passed on Final Reading. We are now ready for LB 76. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 76 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR MARSH: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? LB 76. All those in favor signify by voting aye, opposed no. The Clerk will record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Warner voting yes. Senator Lundy voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Marsh voting yes.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1129 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 76 passes on Final Reading. I would like to welcome to the Legislature a group of students from Springview who are in Senator Lamb's district, 17 kindergarten through eighth graders, in District 76 and 64, accompanied by their teacher.
