SENATOR HIGGINS: In other words you are taking out "other hospitals"?

SENATOR LABEDZ: No, "or other facilities".

SENATOR HIGGINS: What is a facility?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mental...oh, something like DPI, or let me think, Lincoln Regional Center. They are now included in the bill, as amended.

SENATOR HIGGINS: In other words you are broadening the number of people that would get mental health coverage.

SENATOR LABEDZ: That's right, absolutely.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, that's what I wanted to clarify. Thank you.

SENATOR MARSH: Seeing no further lights, we are now ready to vote on the return of LB 487. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return LB 487.

SENATOR MARSH: The bill is returned. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: I move adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: Seeing no further lights, the motion is to adopt the amendment as explained by Senator DeCamp. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting yes.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment to 487.
