CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner as Chair of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee reports on the appointment of Mr. Hod Kosman to the Nebraska Arts Council. That report is on page 1138 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner, Chairman of the committee. (Gavel.) Order, please. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, Miscellaneous Subjects Committee met the other day and unanimously approved the appointment by the Governor of Hod Kosman to the Nebraska Arts Council. Mr. Kosman is from Scottsbluff and maybe our Speaker, Senator Nichol, would have a few words about this too. He is a banker in Scottsbluff so I'm sure that Senator Nichol knows him.
