SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President, members. The amendment that the committee is proposing would clarify that the bill, which now only applies to holding meetings by Bureau of Examining Board, Boards outside of the state for national meetings, would apply to any meeting. Right now the bill says only if you go outside the state to a national meeting and then hold a board meeting would that be in violation of the law. We thought that if it is wrong to have a meeting outside of the state it should be wrong for whatever purpose, whether it be a national meeting that you are attending or whatever. We simply felt that you should broaden the application of the law to any Bureau of Examining Board meeting outside of the state being in violation of the law. So that is the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers.
