CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 1189 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 26 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Back to the bill on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 391 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 391 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on final passage of LB 391. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 1190 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 5 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 391 is declared passed. The Chair announces that Senator Morehead has guests in the north balcony who are 14 seniors from Adams High School accompanied by their teacher. If you will stand, we will recognize you and welcome you to your Nebraska Legislature this morning. The Clerk will read LB 391A.

CLERK: (Read LB 391A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 391A pass? All those in favor vote yes, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Final passage of 391A. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 1190-1191 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 7 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 391A is declared passed. Do you have any further matters for the record at this time, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, just the bills that were read on Final Reading, they are now ready for your signature.
