enforcement officers placed in the position of actually breaking a current law. So, with their request, I introduced LB 259. I urge your advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 259? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 259, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 585.

CLERK: 585, introduced by Senators Schmit and Labedz. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 22, referred to Public Works, advanced to General File. There are Public Works Committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Chairman Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the committee amendments are very simple, simply provide that the duplicate license for this purpose shall be the same as for any other purpose for which you obtain a duplicate. The fee shall be \$2.00. I move the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the committee amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the adoption of committee amendments to LB 585. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LB 585 provides amendments to LB 711, the previous session. The bill does three things.
