PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Remmers.

SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Kathy Seacrest appeared before the committee. It seems to us that she is very well qualified. She has had a lot of experience in various activities. She was a volunteer in activities in North Platte area in the Women's Council, Sexual Assault Task Force, Lincoln County Chapter of the American Red Cross, Advocate for Rape Line, Advisory Committee for City Recreation Program and just a whole host of other experiences she has had. I think she is very well qualified and I would recommend that we confirm the appointment.
