

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner to handle this matter.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I will explain LB 269 a little. It has a fiscal impact of \$29,400 for the fiscal year '85-86 and then it goes up to \$30,800 for fiscal year '86-87. Just let me refresh your memory a little bit on LB 269. This covers the public service entities. It removes work from the county assessors and puts it with the Department of Revenue. LB 269A also covers the fiscal impact for the bill, LB 268. LB 268 changes the taxation of railroads. It places more work on the Department of Revenue and removes some of that work from the county assessors. Mr. President, I move for the advancement of 269A.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the motion to advance 269A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the advancement of 269A. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance 269A.

PRESIDENT: LB 269A is advanced. The next is LB 407A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 407A offered by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. President and members, 407A is a cash fund over in the Department of Health. It will be funded from an increase in fees and a retroactive provision in 407, so there will be no general fund impact to cover the costs of the A bill. I ask for its advancement.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 407A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Please record your vote on LB 407A. The motion has been made to advance the bill from General File. Please record your vote. May we have your cooperation. If you wish to vote, please record your vote. The Chair will allow 15 seconds for the recording of vote.
