LB 407A, 552A

Please record your vote if you wish to vote on the advancement of LB 407A. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I will ask for a call of the house, please, and call in votes.

PRESIDENT: Call of the house has been requested and we may have call in votes. The house is under call. The question is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Take the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call and you may call in your vote to the Clerk. The motion that is pending is the motion to advance LB 269A (sic). Excuse me, 407A. You may call in your vote to the Clerk. Senator Haberman.

CLERK: Senator Goll voting no. Senator Haberman changing from no to yes. Senator Vickers voting yes. Senator Chizek voting yes. Senator DeCamp changing from no to yes. Senator Nichol voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Have you all called your vote in to the Clerk? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 11 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced by that vote. The call of the house is raised. We next take up LB 552A.

CLERK: 552A by Senator Hefner. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the advancement of LB 552A. This is a \$5,000 A bill. This goes along with LB 552. If you will remember when we discussed LB 552, this requires out of state merchants selling goods to Nebraska residents to either file a sales and use tax report collected with the Department of Revenue or furnish a list of names, addresses and amount of sales for those Nebraska residents to whom items were sold. \$5,000...or this is the estimate that the Department of Revenue provided us and this would cover cost of notifying
