CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 1243-44 of the Legislative Journal.) 13 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Beutler amendment fails. May I introduce some guests just coming into the north balcony, please. They are guests of Senator Harris. There are 52 students from the Park Elementary School in Lincoln, Nebraska. They have with them four teachers. Would you please stand and be recognized by your Legislature. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, do you have something else?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, let's just pass over that one. I guess the body is not in the mood to listen to amendments.

If you look at their amendment, on page 1218 (sic) of this bill, where they talk about giving false information to a library concerning your identity or your address for a benefit, it doesn't say that you give the false information to get
