SENATOR MOREHEAD: Well, you will find that...

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...rather than pass laws.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: ...education, as many communities that have worked on education, as many organizations, in itself has not been enough.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I would like to call the question on the amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is, shall debate cease? Do I see five hands? Do I see five hands? Yes, I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on ceasing debate on the amendment to the amendments. If you care to vote, please do so. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate has ceased. Senator Morehead, would you like to close on your amendment to the committee amendments?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Thank you, Mr. President, and members of the body, the amendment to the committee amendments, number one, again reinstates the bill. And after reinstatement of the original bill it then uses Senator Schmit's amendment to clarify issues of contention from the hearing, things such as we didn't ever intend to include motorcycles and mopeds. It eliminates them. We make an exemption for rural mail carriers from the moment of their first stop to their last stop, things like this, and we reinstate a new Section 6 on mitigation. So I would ask for your adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments. Thank you.
