CLERK: 20 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Morehead's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Morehead amendments to the committee amendments are adopted. Do you have other amendments to the committee amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do from Senator Hoagland. Senator Hoagland is excused.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Has anyone been designated to handle Senator Hoagland's amendment? If not, do you have others?

CLERK: I have nothing further to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we are back to the committee amendments then. Those are debatable. If there is no discussion, does anybody wish...Senator Marsh. One moment, please. There you are.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I do move for the amended committee amendments. I want to tell you in answer to one of the questions a previous speaker said, there now is 67 percent compliance with the child restraint law in my county as of the report that just came out the 27th of March and I'm very pleased and proud to report that. That is about three times as many protected as before the law was passed. Let's adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Peterson, did you wish to speak on the committee amendments? Okay. Senator Remmers, on the committee amendments...the bill? Senator Hefner, the committee amendments.
