SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: If that is not a change that he really would intend to make.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, did you hear the question that she proposed to you?

SENATOR HABERMAN: No, I didn't.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Senator Morehead, would you repeat the question for Senator Haberman.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I would suggest to Senator Haberman that his intention was not to exclude all the vehicles which we have included. So rather than say passenger automobiles, it should say motor vehicles.

SENATOR HABERMAN: That's fine.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: So when he is turning in a new amendment that change should be made also I believe.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Were you through, Senator Morehead?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes, I am.
