SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I wish someone would define what a motor vehicle is then.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler, perhaps you'd wish to do that since it's your amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I don't believe I can do that at this point in time because I'm going to have to look back in the statutes and so I can't do that. I'm picking up the language that is in the rest of the amendment, so if it's wrong here, then it's wrong everywhere, but I'm sure that they have it right here at this point in time and so it should be consistent.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Senator Carsten, we'll see if Senator Beutler wishes to add further to his answer to you. Senator Morehead, do you have the answer?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes, Mr. President. Let's see...I'm looking up the section number. Section 39-602 in the Nebraska statutes defines, "Motor vehicles shall mean every self-propelled land vehicle not operated upon rails except mopeds and self-propelled invalid chairs."

SPEAKER NICHOL: Does that say motorcycles, Senator Morehead?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: It says mopeds and we have been redundant in our amendment to clarify that for the lobby that was concerned about it. It also goes on to define all the other motorcycles, motor driven cycles, et cetera. I'll be happy to share it with Senator Carsten.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, we're through with Senator Cal Carsten's time. Now I believe that I have called on everyone. Senator Beutler, if you'd like to close on your amendment to the amendment. I believe that is where we are.
