Two years down the road all the facts are stale, they are gone. It is called like a hot trail or a fresh trail. We don't have the resources in the political subdivisions that you do in the state government or the federal government and we don't have the financial wherewithal. Remember, we are talking about tax dollars. Now again I would say, look at the list, please, that I have put on your desk and you can see how other states have treated their liability.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: You will see that Nebraska has the among the top three most liberal policies already on the books giving a person one year to just say, I have got a claim, I want you to look at it. And we have no liability cap, no ceiling on what we can have as far as a claim against us. We have already got a very liberal policy, one of the most liberal in the country, and if you look at the other states, you can see they give them thirty days. They give them six months, ninety days. Many of them put a cap of \$12,000 on a claim, \$100,000 on a claim, \$500,000 on an occurrence. We have one of the most liberal already. There is absolutely no reason to take it further than we already have and that is why we want to bring this out as an individual issue.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Higgins.
