SENATOR HANNIBAL: Certainly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hannibal, had the committee just outright killed the bill, would you still be making a motion to bring it out on the floor despite the action of the committee?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Yes, I believe so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Thank you. Then I don't feel any qualms of conscience about the approach that I am taking. That was all that I wanted to ask you. And I would have moved to kill that bill and I would have supported the killing of it. Senator Hannibal may have a point in what he is talking about because there could be provisions in the other bill that maybe he doesn't even like. But I still want 289 to stay killed. But, Senator Hannibal, I haven't achieved my purpose because they have sent something that is objectionable to me out here with your bill attached to it. So should I want to deal with malaria and scarlet fever individually on different days or should I let them put malaria and scarlet fever in one package and try to find something that will wipe them both out at the same time, or hope that some people who don't fear scarlet fever might fear malaria and some who are in the vice versa position will help me kill both of them which is what I really want to do see happen? I am going to vote against bringing
