

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, the amendment which we propose here would strike Section 1 of the bill, LB 387. There are some people who are nervous. They think that this gives the Natural Resource Districts the ability to issue general obligation bonds. That was never the intent of the original legislation. By striking Section 1 we remove all doubt about that and it will give these people a little more peace of mind. The NRD has the authority to issue limited obligation bonds. We do not want to confuse the issue. Therefore, I move the bill be returned to strike Section 1.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the amendment as explained by Senator Schmit. All those in favor of adopting the amendment please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is adopted. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be readvanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We will move on to LB 28 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: (Read LB 28 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor
