SENATOR DECAMP: Well, I suppose...yes, sure.

SENATOR DECAMP: Pardon?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Will it hurt the Legislature's image if we kill it?

SENATOR DECAMP: Oh, no, it won't hurt our image.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Will it help our image if we don't pass it?

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, I suppose not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. I am going to draw some conclusions from this.

SENATOR DECAMP: The bill probably won't hurt or help anybody either way. With the passage of Amendment 4 the whole rules have been changed, in my humble opinion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Members of the Legislature, I was hoping that enough people had listened to the discussion the other day and would remember it but sometimes you don't when you get to Final Reading. The bill is not needed. I think it could actually be hurtful. So I have made the motion to return it to strike the enacting clause and I hope you will support that motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner. And, Senator Chambers, I am sorry for ringing the bell, it was an accident. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I voted against the bill and I voted against advancing it, maybe somewhat different reasons. I don't disagree with what has previously been discussed but my
