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SPEAKER NICHOL: We are at the point where the bill is on Select File, and unless someone moves to advance it, it stays there.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We don't have to dispose of that motion?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Not if you withdraw it, in other words...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Before I make a decision, may I approach the bench.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. While we are at ease, may I announce some special guests of Senator Nelson under the north balcony. There are 11 members of the Grand Island Chamber of Commerce. These members represent the Legislative Branch of the Chamber of Commerce in Grand Island. Would you please stand and be recognized by the Legislature. Thank you for attending the Legislature this morning. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I spoke with Senator Eret, with yourself, and the Clerk and we have decided that the best thing to do is leave the bill right where it is in its present situation until we can work everything else out, so that is what I would like to do at this point.
