

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 335.

CLERK: (Read LB 335 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1275 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 335...okay, 340 now.

CLERK: (Read LB 340 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted please? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1276 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 1 nay, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr President.

CLERK: (Read LB 373 on Final Reading.)
