LB 383A, 383

SENATOR ABOUD: No.

SENATOR HABERMAN: You say it does not include gasoline or diesel, is that correct?

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you.

SENATOR ABOUD: It doesn't.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, any further questions? Senator Abboud, did you wish to close? Okay, the question is, shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays to advance LB 383, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 383 passes, advances, I should say. LB 383A.

CLERK: 383A offered by Senators Abboud and Hannibal. (Read title.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Yes, Mr. President, this is a cash fund appropriation which will be paid for by the businesses that send in the information to the State Fire Marshal. It is not a general fund appropriation. I move the advancement of LB 383A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, you have heard the explanation. Senator Hannibal, excuse me.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. Speaker and members, I do support the appropriations. I thought it would be appropriate only to make one comment that the committee statement or the committee amendments did set this bill up with a limit on the fee and that fee was a maximum of \$10 but I believe the bill refers to a cost incurred fee up to a maximum and I just thought it would be good to have it on the record that this is not setting a limit or setting a floor or setting the fee at \$10. It was saying the fee shall only go up to a maximum. I think the preliminary indications are that the fee could be established at far below that \$1 or \$10 maximum
