we would have the option to have more flexibility in our rules and regulations through the Department of Health. The intent is clearly to recognize in some of our smaller facilities in our rural areas that sometimes these regulations just don't make much sense. So to provide the waiver in these instances makes sense, and is one that we would ask your support for. So that is what the amendment does. It is amending LB 248, as amended by committee, into LB 253. I'd ask your support for the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Wesely? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the Wesely amendment to LB 253. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment to LB 253, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, do you want to move it?

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move LB 253 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to advance the bill, LB 253. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. LB 253 is advanced. LB 253A

CLERK: Senator, I have no amendments to the A bill.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 253A be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion has been made to advance LB 253A. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay. We'd like to ask that the A bill be passed over at this time, Mr. President.
