

piece of legislation next year that is going to repeal the right to work laws in this state, and I expect every one of those people that are opposing me today to be in there supporting it next year because it is exactly the same issue. We in agriculture are, talk about being not very consistent, we are some of the worst people about not being consistent. We say that we don't want forced unionism in this state, and we jump up and down and raise hell about it. Then we turn right around and say, well, unless it's in our own industry, and then forced unionism is okay. Well, forced unionism is not okay. I think we ought to have a right to work state. I don't think it makes any difference if you are a carpenter, or if you are a corn farmer, you still ought to have that right to work without having to belong to any particular group or organization and contribute money to it. If they are afraid of the people taking their dollars out, then maybe they better clean up their act. But I think LB 60 is an important bill. You know we can talk about promotion. We can talk about how we're going to expand the use of our products, and I told a story with 456, I don't have time for it here, but it basically went this way what would happen if we...if the corn growers or the corn board would come up with a new product and I called in corn butter and we just simply did away with peanut butter and corn butter was the greatest thing since sliced bread.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR VICKERS: People would start raising more corn all over the place. And is there anybody that really thinks that, in itself, would raise the price of corn? Of course it wouldn't, of course it wouldn't. The difference between us advertising in our industry and advertising in car industry is that we cannot control our production. If I think the price is going to go up I'm going to raise more, and so does everybody else. We've got to get in the arena where prices are really affected, and that is in the legislative arena. Therefore, I think LB 60 is important. But as I said earlier, you can only do it if those checkoff dollars are refundable. I urge the adoption of this amendment, Mr. President.
