SPEAKER NICHOL: Well...

SENATOR DECAMP: I move adoption of the amendment. It is a purely technical amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely. Senator Haberman. Senator Wesely, your light is on, did you wish to talk about the technical amendment? Senator DeCamp, did you wish to close?

SENATOR DECAMP: No.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the technical amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It is on page 1326 if you would like to look in your Journal. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator DeCamp's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The DeCamp amendment is adopted. Do you have anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hartnett would move to amend and Senator Hartnett's amendment is on page 1342 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hartnett, please.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, it is just a technical amendment like...

SPEAKER NICHOL: I assume you do not wish to explain it then.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...like Senator DeCamp. Offutt Air Force Base is located in my district and I think that it affects that. We are the only state that does not have restrictions on the number of alcohol that can be brought into the district...or into the state, and so this kind of brings this in line with the other states of the Union. And I think we have a handout that we passed out to you, a copy of the proposed amendment, a copy of a letter from the Attorney General and a copy of the federal guidelines relating to this bill, and a summary of the other states.
