PRESIDENT: Will members please record your presence for roll call. Members throughout the building, please take notice that the hour of one-thirty has arrived and we are ready to take up the afternoon's legislative work. Members of the Legislature, please report to the George W. Norris Unicameral Legislative Chamber, located on the west side of the Capitol Building, second floor. We will begin the afternoon session as soon as we have a quorum. You will be interested to know that the galleries are filling up before the floor of the Legislature. Members of the Legislature, please come to the Legislative Chamber so that we may begin the afternoon session. A roll call is in progress. We're asking you to record your presence. Members of the Legislature, you are invited to come to the Legislative Chamber to take part in the afternoon's legislative session and to join our quorum which is now in the process of being taken. Members of the Legislature, please report to the Senate Chamber for the afternoon's session. A roll call is in progress on the legislative floor. Will members of the Legislature please come to the Chamber and record your presence so that we may acquire a quorum to begin this afternoon's session. We will continue the discussion of the seat belt bill, LB 496. Would you tally the roll, Mr. Clerk.
