

SENATOR MOREHEAD: No, they are not going out and inspect every belt, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So they could all be defective and they still would be...would meet with the requirements of this bill. Thank you. I'm not going to prolong it. I'll try to speak again, but...

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The Chair allowed the discussion to go on in order for that colloquy to continue, thinking it was important for the debate. Senator Morehead, I think you are now entitled to close on your amendment to the Haberman amendment, and, of course, this amendment, when we take the vote, we'll have a majority...simple majority. We're on Select File, so it requires 25 votes. Senator Chambers, did you have a point?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Response inaudible.)

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, members of the body, at this time I think the easiest thing to do would be to show Senator DeCamp how flexible we are in this body and for me to withdraw my amendment and speak to the defeat of Senator Haberman's amendment. So at this time I ask to withdraw my amendment and for the defeat of Senator Haberman's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Very well. We are back...Senator Morehead has withdrawn her amendment. We're back on the Morehead amendment...the Haberman amendment rather. Senator Beutler, do you want to speak on the Haberman amendment? Let's start a whole new list now of speakers. It would be helpful if you would extinguish your lights and put them on again if you wish to speak.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, if I understand it correctly, basically the Haberman amendment would say that anybody that snipped off their seat belt, or unbolted their seat belt is home free. If that is the case then essentially what you are saying is you don't want any law at all, and I guess I don't see any purpose to any extended debate on this amendment. If you are for the seat belt law, vote against it. If you are against the seat belt law, vote for it. It is as simple as that.
