

floor even though it is not one of our major bills this year. So I suggest to you that for purposes of the precedent this year, for purposes of what is the right thing for this bill, that we should hold to this decision and not be reconsidering every bill that we kill, especially since this one is being held until next year anyway and actually it should be reintroduced next year and go through committee. That would be a better process for this bill. And they can get their action next year just the same, one way or the other. But if we are going to start this process, it just seems to me it is going to be an interminable process of reconsideration and reconsideration and reconsideration and that that kind of reconsideration, especially when the objective is not to hear it this year but to put it off till next year just doesn't make a lot of sense. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Marsh, please.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this may not be an important bill to Senator Beutler, but it is a very important bill to many of the librarians and the library boards in the State of Nebraska. I will vote in support of LB 288. I also will work to put it into a form when we return to discuss it next year. Thank you very much.
