CLERK: 14 nays, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The house is under call. All senators will please return to the Chamber and push their green buttons, record their presence, please. Please push your buttons. Looking for Senator Chambers, Senator Lamb. Please push your button, Marge. Senator Rogers, sign in. Okay, Senator Lamb is here. We are just waiting for Senator Chambers. Okay, we will proceed with the roll call vote. The motion before the body is Senator Peterson's motion to raise LR 33 notwithstanding the action of the committee. A reverse call on the roll call has been requested. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk, in reverse.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 1389 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to raise the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion fails. While we are moving on...before we move on to the next item of business, I would like to introduce to you and ask you to welcome to the Legislature 20 seniors from Waterloo, Nebraska, and their teachers, who are in the north balcony and who are guests of Senator Beyer. Please welcome them to the Legislature. The call is raised. In addition to that, we would like to welcome to the Legislature guests of Senator Sieck, 40 fourth graders from Centennial School in Utica, Nebraska, who are also in the north balcony, let's see your hands, yes, and their teacher.
