SENATOR BEUTLER: One minute, Gerry.

SENATOR CONWAY: What these particulars are relative to, certificate of insurance, beyond the insurance item, if you will notice under the financial responsibilities category that there are other ways of proving your financial responsibility. You can post a bond. You can be involved in a self-insurance pool, and so forth. I contacted the Department of Motor Vehicles and I believe there are 17 people or insured people who are involved with the Department of Motor Vehicles using one of these other techniques besides insurance. So the certificate...in providing the certificate and we are talking about a specific certificate with a seal affixed to that, that is for those unique cases where they do not want to go to a common insurance carrier but want to post a bond. And so that is what the certificate concept is. Other than that, we use the cover sheets that the insurance company sends out.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, before we move on to the next speaker, a couple of items. First of all, the noise level here is becoming very high and I have had a couple of requests from members of the Legislature to remind people to keep it quiet so everybody can hear.
