

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion before the body is the indefinite postponement of LB 645. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. A simple majority is the rule. Please vote. Senator Johnson, I think we just as well entertain your motion.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: I think we will have the motion to have a call of the house and a roll call vote please.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: We are under call. Will all Senators please return to the Chamber and record their presence please? Push those green buttons. Everybody record their presence. Please return to the Chamber and record your presence. How many are excused, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: There are 7 excused, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Chambers, Senator Hefner, Senator Lamb, Senator Lynch, Senator Nelson, Senator Pappas, please return to the Chamber. Senators Chambers, Lamb, Lynch, Pappas, please return to the Chamber. Senator Lamb, Senator Chambers. Okay, Senator Lamb is here and Senator Chambers is here. I think, Senator Johnson, that those are all who are in the building. Do you wish to proceed with the roll call vote? Okay, the motion before the body again is the indefinite postponement of LB 645. Call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1396-97 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion fails. We are back on the main bill. Are there any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?
