CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the committee amendments are adopted. Senator Schmit, did you wish to explain the bill further?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I believe, Mr. Chairman, that Senator Lamb has an amendment which he might want to offer at this time. I have no objections.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I understand there is an amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb would move to amend the bill. (Lamb amendment appears on page 1400 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, this is sort of a minor amendment. On page 8, line 13 after the word "commission" insert "Failure of a member state to provide its share of financing shall be cause for the state to lose its membership in the compact." And looking through the language of the bill, we did not see a place in there where it was perfectly clear that if a member at any time decided not to pay its membership dues, that it would fail to be a member on a continuing basis, just a slight clarification of the language.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, is there anyone who wishes to discuss the Lamb amendment? I see no lights. Senator Lamb, do you wish to close on the amendment? Okay, the motion before the body then is the Lamb amendment to the committee amendments, Mr. Clerk, Lamb amendment to the bill, excuse me. The motion is the Lamb amendment to the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting aye, Pat.
