SPEAKER NICHOL: Are you withdrawing your motion?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yeah, I think so.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, thank you. It is withdrawn. We'll move on to the General File, LB 208A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 208A offered by Senator Withem. (Title read.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, 208 was the bill that I had sponsored which involves the shrinkage allowance, in reducing the shrinkage allowance. The Department of Revenue told us they needed a very slight amount of money and I forget exactly what the dollar amount is, but it is a small sum of money to implement this bill. They asked us to come forward with an A bill and we have done so. I'd appreciate your adoption of this bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of LB 208A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 208A, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: 208A is advanced. LB 347A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 347A was a bill offered by Senator Harris. (Title read.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Harris.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this bill was advanced and it was to split the investment opportunities for the public employees. This is an accounting measure that needs to be enacted. It does not deal in the amounts of money that are listed in the A bill. It's simply an accounting measure and it has to be done. Mr. President, I move the advancement of the A bill.
