SPEAKER NICHOL: I think it's been talked probably to death, Mr. President. Under the present conditions, I would simply move that the bill be advanced. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, any further discussion? The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 333, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 333 is advanced. Senator Barrett, did you wish to take up 333A, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, 333A offered by Senator Barrett. (Title read.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Mr. President and members, the A bill to 333 calls for an appropriation of \$8,860 to the Department of Health; \$2,940 to the Department of Social Services; some nearly \$12,000. I should also hasten to add that it anticipates raising \$151,000 a year. Move the advancement.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 333A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the motion to advance LB 333A, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 333A is advanced. LB 632.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might right before that, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 209 correctly engrossed, 209A, 253, 253A, 346, 413A, 451A all correctly engrossed, all signed by Senator Hall as Chairman of E & R. (See page 1418 of the Legislative Journal.)
