SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the committee amendments? If not, the question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Excuse me, there are amendments to the committee amendments. It makes it...okay, he said he'd make his bill, so we're voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted and you have amendments now.

CLERK: Senator, would you care to take up your amendment now or the bill?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yah, I'll take it up now.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to amend the bill. (Johnson amendment appears on page 1424 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, this particular amendment you have on your desk. I had given it to the Clerk the other day but I had neglected to tell him to print it in the Journal, which was my fault. It's a very simple amendment. It would increase the ADC payment from the committee level of \$300 a month for a parent and one child to \$325 a month for a parent and one child. You will find on your desk among all of the debris that you receive over the course of a morning, you will find a lot of things that I have had passed out, one of which is a fiscal impact statement on this bill. You will note that the bill as currently amended will cost the State of Nebraska an additional \$1.3 million for the first six months of implementation and an additional \$2.7 million for a full fiscal year. You will note that the amendment that I am proposing will cost the State of Nebraska \$2.6 million for the first six months of implementation and \$5.4 million for a full fiscal year.
