

above the age 18. That's gone now. That's just plain gone. There have been a lot of changes like that so we are narrowing the class of people that we're providing benefits to. Again, scholars are indicating that in the last 15 years in particular there has been a dramatic decrease in the level of assistance and support to low income children and families, a dramatic increase in the level of support to the elderly population, but it is the children and the families that are the most poor.
