LB 72, 190, 393, 452, 505

SENATOR BEUTLER: Please vote. Please vote. It is a majority of those voting. Is there anybody else that wishes to vote? I am about to call for the recording of the vote. Senator Chronister, did I hear you ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote?

SENATOR CHRONISTER: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The house is under call. All members will return to the Chamber and record their presence, please. Push your buttons. How many are excused, Mr. Clerk? Five excused, Senator Chronister. Senator Baack, push your button. Senator Chambers, Senator Abboud, Senator Rod Johnson, please return to the Chamber. Okay, are we ready to proceed, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Call the roll on Senator Warner's motion to indefinitely postpone the bill.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 1436-37 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The motion carries. Are we ready to move on to the next item, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, right before that, if I might, Senator DeCamp has an Opinion, an Attorney General's Opinion on LB 452. (See pages 1437-39 of the Legislative Journal.)
