

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the bill be returned from Final Reading for a specific amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Four are excused.

I think if only four are excused there are three who are probably out and we ought to just, number one, check in and if I have to do a roll call vote I do a roll call vote, but I guess we should check in first and locate everybody who is not excused.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. The question is, check in. Poke your green button, please. We are on Final Reading. Call in votes are authorized.

CLERK: Senator Morehead voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Haberman has asked for a roll call vote. Then we'll finish our checking in. Look up to see if your green light is lit, if not...thank you. Looking for Senator Wesely, Senator Labedz, Senator Landis. Looking for Senator Wesely and Senator Labedz. Now just Senator Labedz. I understand Senator Labedz is on her way so if you'd please return to your seats and we can begin the roll call as soon as Senator Labedz gets here. Thank you. All right, Mr. Clerk. Let's hold your conversation down so the Clerk can hear the response. We're voting on the return of the bill so all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote read as found on page 1457 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is returned. Now, Senator Vard Johnson.
