

SENATOR LAMB: And have a roll call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. We will clear the board and please punch your green button. Those that have wandered astray, please return and record your presence. Senator Rupp, Senator Chambers and Senator Rod Johnson are excused. A few of you have not recorded your presence. Please do so. Thank you. We are looking for Senator Wesely, Senator Schmit, Senator Landis, Senator Haberman, Senator Hall, Senator Pirsch. Looking for Senator Schmit, Senator Hall, Senator Pirsch.
