CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is returned...the bill is returned. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? I see no lights. The question is the adoption of the Landis amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Landis amendment is adopted. Do you have anything else? We're back on the bill. Senator Landis, you want to readvance the bill, please.

SENATOR LANDIS: I move to readvance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye...Oh, Senator Lamb wishes a machine vote, so all those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record vote has been asked for, too. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1469 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is advanced. Do you have anything else?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, the next motion I have is by...Senator Schmit, I'm back to yours. (See Schmit amendment found on pages 1469-70 of the Legislative Journal.)
