In any event to shorten the time period and to increase the dollar amount that the Legislature has to come up with, doing both of those things as the DeCamp amendment does, is going to put the Legislature in an enormous bind and it's going to put us in an enormous bind in a political year, and we're going to have trouble getting legislative support, and we're going to have trouble getting gubernatorial support for those kinds of things in a year where there is an election, and we all know that. So again I would just plead with you to put into that bill that which is realistic. This amendment does not represent a realistic goal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis, please.

SENATOR LANDIS: I call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Question has been called. Question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. You should be in your seats, incidentally, ladies and gentlemen. We're voting on ceasing debate. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate ceases. Senator DeCamp, do you wish to close?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I'm dead serious about this amendment and you should be too. It is three complete legislative sessions you'd have to do this. It would not be in an election year. It is after, I repeat, after the '86-87 fiscal year. That means you have '85, '86 which is the election year, and the long session of 1987 1987 included. The best time of all to get the job done. Total cost, \$150 million by Senator Warner's own figures he just gave me. The 40 percent, not, not an unrealistic figure. This body voted, just a few days ago, to do 30 percent or 33 percent. Right? So am I the one being unrealistic or are the people who claim they want to get education redone, but want to spread it for five full years before they get anything done? You are going to have a whole new Legislature by '89, you know it and I know it. Shoot,
