

see that there is any logic in her argument whatsoever. She is arguing, it seems to me, for a change in the policy that we've set in place so far, but it would seem to me that that is the kind of detail that this study commission is all about. We can do the study, and if the policy...the minute policy change, as being suggested by Senator Scofield is appropriate, we can change it next year. I share Senator Vard Johnson's concern and I share Senator Landis's concern about what is happening, jockeying this bill back and forth between Select File and Final Reading. I would point out to you specifically, with regard to the amendment that we sent back to Select File on Jackie Smith's...changing Jackie Smith's amendment so that it included freshmen and sophomores, that the vote on that was overwhelming to send it back to Select File. But when the vote was taken to return it to Final Reading, it made it by 25 votes. So it is clear to me what is happening now, they are voting yes, send it back to Select, that is a great idea, and when it gets back there then they are trying to trap the bill back there. It is a legislative technique that is time-honored, and we've seen it many times before. There is nothing illegitimate about it, but you should all recognize what is happening and act accordingly.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, the issue that Senator Scofield brings forth with this amendment, I think, is one that could very well be handled by E & R because of the enactment date of the bill we've already agreed upon. So I, too, share the concern of Senators Beutler, Landis and Johnson. I would urge the body to not bring the bill back for the Scofield amendment.
