SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 349 passes. LB 356, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Richard Peterson and Senator Hoagland would move to return LB 356 to Select File for a specific amendment. That amendment is found on page 1459 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Richard Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President and members, I would like to bring this bill back and attach this amendment on that was caught and Motor Vehicles has also said that it should be on the bill. And that being on the bill, on page 2, line 10, after "court" insert "or by an administrative order of the Director of Motor Vehicles." The purpose of this amendment is to reinstate the penalty for driving on a license that has been administratively revoked or suspended. As the bill currently stands without this amendment, the Director of Motor Vehicles administratively revocation procedures would be effectively gutted and these administrative procedures are currently used like to invoke driving...a driver who has accumulated a number of points or has an alcohol breath test, those type of things. And so I ask that you bring it back and reinstate this into the bill, make it conform. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I think Senator Peterson has adequately explained this technical amendment. I have distributed to you a letter from Holly Jensen dated April 9th and an Attorney General's Opinion that was secured by her office...I am sorry, by the County Attorney out in McCook, Nebraska in February of this year. The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that the Department of Motor Vehicles is able to retain authority it currently has to suspend licenses under certain circumstances. Again, it is strictly of a technical nature to be sure that we are not repealing inadvertently authorities they currently have to enforce the drunk driving laws and point revocation laws and laws of a similar nature.
