

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Peterson, what is the rush? I mean, we get these bills and they wait until it gets to Final Reading, then they find something wrong with it affecting their power, then they want us to immediately take their word that what they are telling us is the truth, amend the bill and act on it immediately. Now, I can't stop you from making whatever motion you are going to make and if you get 25 votes, you have got it made. But I hope the Legislature will proceed with caution and I guess I will just have to let their motion play its way out, except that I want to ask for a point of order here. Mr. Chairman, does a motion, we are on Final Reading to lay over or bracket to a day certain which is what I would do, take priority over a motion to return a bill for the purpose of a specific amendment?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, it would come back in plenty time, I am sure, if that is what you are getting at.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What I am going to do is interpose a motion. If a motion to bracket to a day certain would take priority over their motion to return for a specific amendment, I want to make that motion. But since I am not certain, I would like to give the Chair time to find out for sure.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, just a second. Senator Chambers, if it is agreeable with you, they want to put the amendment on anyway and then you can file a bracketing motion after that for a certain length of time, which will hold it, and I told Senator Peterson that it will get back on Final Reading providing things get worked out in adequate time. Would that be agreeable with you?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am going to...I am asking, does a motion to bracket to a day certain take priority over a motion to return?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I am making a motion to bracket LB 356 until April 12th.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right.
