

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And now I will address the motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: A staff member had had the feeling that this amendment that was adopted on that page of the Journal that was referred to in the Director's letter may have affected the law in the way that the department had said. But he agrees that it is subject to interpretation. It was his feeling that that may be the case and he thought the department should be aware of it. I am not sure that I agree with that.
